**NROTC SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**  
*Friday, 18 August 2023*

**Scheme of Maneuver:** NROTC Scholarship students and family members shall report to Kilbourne Hall, Room 2089 at 0900 on Friday, 18 August 2023. All students shall report in appropriate civilian attire to receive a “Welcome Aboard” brief by NROTCU VMI Commanding Officer and subsequently have the opportunity to ask questions. Following the brief, parents will depart the room and students will complete their NROTC scholarship paperwork. Upon completion of all scholarship-related paperwork, the Commanding Officer will administer the Oath of Office to the scholarship students (witnessed by their family members). Taking the Midshipman Oath of Office officially activates the NROTC Scholarship. As a final event to the morning, NROTCU VMI will provide a lunch to students and their families, after which students will be released for the remainder of the day. Students and their families shall conduct VMI Matriculation on 19 August, in accordance with VMI guidance.

**Timeline of Events (Friday, 18 August 2023):**

- 0900-0945:** NROTC Scholarship students report to Kilbourne Hall, Room 2089.
- 0945-1145:** Students fill out scholarship paperwork, Room 2089. Families move to Room 3020 for question/answer session and refreshments.
- 1200-1215:** Midshipman Oath of Office, Kilbourne Hall Foyer.
- 1215-1300:** Lunch for Midshipman and Families, Room 3020.
