

2022-2023 Dependent Verification 1 Worksheet Federal Student Aid Programs

Your application was selected by the U.S. Dept. of Education for review process called "verification." In this process, we are required by federal law to verify information provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To verify this information, the IRS Tax Return Transcript is required. Documentation regarding number of children in college may be required.

We cannot process your financial aid until verification has been completed.

1. Complete, sign (student and at least one parent) and return the worksheet.

2. Parents who are **NON-Tax Filers** need to complete IRS Form <u>4506-T</u> to receive a "Verification of NON-Filing" letter" and submit letter to our office. Please call IRS at 1-800-908-9946 with any questions.

3. Please use **IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT)** on your FAFSA or submit **Tax Return Transcript** for 2020 (IRS Form 1040, 1040A or 1040ez are <u>not</u> sufficient), and any other documents requested, to our office.

4. We will compare the information on these documents to your FAFSA and make corrections if necessary.
